The 2010 Donald Mitchell Bursary

The 2010 Donald Mitchell Bursary has been set up by the BC Association of Professional Archaeologists (BCAPA) for a BCAPA Student Member who will be attending a field school within British Columbia in the 2010 calendar year.

This bursary is a non-repayable limited grant of \$500, with preference given to those students who demonstrate financial need. The selection process will also encourage other criteria such as extracurricular involvement and leadership in the BC student archaeology community, and is meant to supplement, not replace, the selected student's primary source(s) of funding. Bursaries are considered to be part of a student's taxable income for the year by Revenue Canada.

Regulations

- The bursary must be used only for the purpose you apply for (field school tuition fees).
- The successful applicant will receive the bursary upon proof of registration in a field school course.
- Only the successful applicant will be notified of the bursary decision in writing.
- Members of the Awards Committee are excluded as possible references.

Requirements/Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for this bursary the applicant must:

1. Currently be a Student member of the BCAPA;
2. Remain a BCAPA Student member for the duration of the 2010 school year;
3. Be enrolled in a BC College or University during the 2010 school year;
4. Be enrolled in a field school which will take place within British Columbia during the 2010 school year; and,
5. Complete the Bursary Application form posted on the "News" page of the BCAPA website (www.bcapca.bc.ca) and supplied to the membership via the email list, clearly demonstrating why they are a suitable candidate for the bursary.

Where to Apply

The winning bursary will be selected and authorized by the BCAPA Awards Committee. Completed applications must be submitted to the Awards Committee at: awardscommittee@bcapca.bc.ca.

Bursary Application Deadline

Applications must be received by the BCAPA Awards Committee by **5:00 pm** on the deadline date of **April 30, 2010**.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
